INSTRUCTIONS

- (Variety) If you are entering a dog of breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).
- The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
- (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e. age division, color division, weight division.
- A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name. Each dog that passes will receive a framed copy of their actual track. (Maps will be mailed at a later date.)

LIMITATION OF ENTRIES

Entries close Monday, February 14, at 6:00 p.m. at the office of the test secretary. Entries cannot be accepted, cancelled or substituted after this date and time.

This test is limited to (4) four TD and (4) four TDX entries, AKC registered dogs six months of age or older. Preference will be given to dogs without a TD title in the TD test. TDX titleholders may run in the TDX test, but dogs without a TDX title will be given preference.

Note: If the limit for entries is not reached in one test and the limit is exceeded in the other test, the number of tracks will be exchanged up to the limit set by the AKC Tracking Regulations.

Bitches in season will be allowed at this test but will be run last, in accordance with American Kennel Club Tracking Regulations, Ch.2 Sec.8. Any bitch which appears so attractive to males as to be a disturbing element is considered to be in season.

DRAWING OF ENTRIES

Entries will be accepted until the official closing date, even if the advertised limit has been reached. DRAWING OF ENTRIES will be held at 7:00 p.m., Wednesday, February 16, 2011 at Hugh Smith Recreation Center in Arlington, Texas. This drawing will be at random. All Entries will be notified of the draw results as soon as possible.

ALTERNATE ENTRIES

When the advertised limit has been drawn, all remaining entries, subject to the same preference set forth in the preceding paragraph, shall be assigned a position on an Alternate List corresponding to the order in which they were drawn, in accordance with Chapter 1, Section 12 of the American Kennel Club Tracking Regulations.

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THE DAY OF THE TEST

The Tests must be judged by two judges. Track numbers will be assigned by a drawing at the **Track Site Headquarters on Sunday, February 27, 2011 at 7:30 a.m. for the TD . The TDX draw on the day of the Tests will be held at 9:45 am at the corner of Northern Cross Boulevard and Anderson Boulevard.** (This is the approximate location of the last TD test for the day.)

Should an entered handler not be present, he will be marked absent and an alternate will be chosen to run the track. The first track will be run as soon as conditions allow. The assignment of dogs to the tracks by this drawing is the responsibility of the judges.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

*Entry fees will not be refunded in the event a dog is absent, or disqualified, excused by the Veterinarian or Judges, or barred from competition by action of the Tracking Test Committee. There will be no refund for duplicate entries. No entry fee will be refunded if the test cannot be held or completed for any cause beyond the control of the Club. *Changes, additions or corrections to entry forms must be received in writing. Those received by telephone are not acceptable.

*Dogs need be present only at the scheduled time of judging according to the Judging Program that will be mailed to exhibitors and alternates.

*Alcoholic beverages are prohibited from the test site. There shall be no smoking on the tracking field.

*The TTCOC Test Committee will exercise reasonable care for the safety of all exhibitors and dogs , but will not be responsible for any loss, damage or injury to any dog, handler or property.

DOGS WILL BE REQUIRED AT ALL TIMES TO BE LEASHED OR CRATED.

NOTE: AKC Tracking Regulations, Chapter 1, Section 16: "A dog that is allowed to run free and off lead, at any time before the test, during the test, after failing or after the completion of its track, shall be failed and excused. If this occurs before the test, the dog shall be excused and not allowed to run in the test." (Amended to October 1, 2000)
